Thank you for inquiring on the AMMOP program at Tec Voc. AMMOP stands for **Aerospace Manufacturing** and **Maintenance Orientation Program**.

This program will cover many different areas in the Aerospace industry.

Program Elements

- Aircraft Components & Functions
- Aircraft Engine Fundamental (both Piston and Gas Turbine)
- Aviation Math & Physics
- Blueprint Reading & Technical Drawings
- Composite Fabrication & Repair
- Mentorship
- Non-Destructive Testing
- Principles of Flight (both Fixed & Rotary)
- Sheet Metal Fabrication & Repair
- Test of Workplace Essential Skills (TOWES) preparation
- Work Experience

Duration and Hours

- 10-month part time program, starting in September and ending in June
- We run two classes during the year. You would be enrolled in either Monday/Tuesday every second Wednesday or the Thursday/Friday every second Wednesday class
- Classes run from 7:50am to 2:20pm at Tec Voc High School

Cost

- The course itself is FREE of charge
- Individual work boots will be required
- A one-time fee of \$500 to be paid by the end of August 2026 to cover individual tool kits and materials

Work Experience

• At the end of the program there is a two-week, everyday work experience component

Open House and Applications

- Open House: April 15th, 2026 at Tec Voc at 6pm
- At that time, we will accept paper applications for the program
- You need to be a Canadian Citizen or a Permanent Resident (provide proof with PR)
- Grade 12 is required and a transcript accompanying the application
