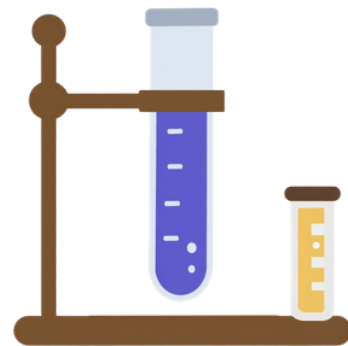

The Scholastic Spring Book Fair was a success!

Our school earned ~**\$1,200** in Scholastic credit from both sales and the \$300 'Second Fair of the Year' bonus we received. ~**\$650** was spent on books from teachers wish lists, supporting our classroom libraries, and the other ~**\$550** was spent on books for the main library.

In this fair, we introduced the **Book Reorder** process, which helps make the book fair more equitable, assuring that families who can't make it to the fair on the first day still have access to all of the same books on the second day.
