VOX meets at 7:50am on every day 2, 4 & 6 in room 101. This is an auditioned ensemble and students must also be members of the Senior Choir.

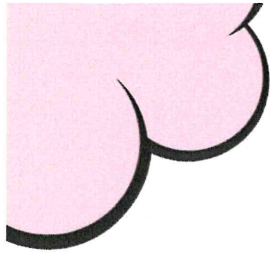
URBAN AND JUNIOR FUSION

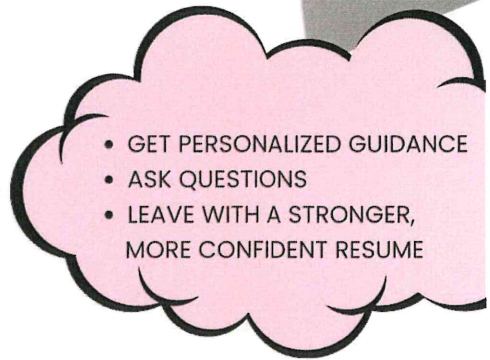

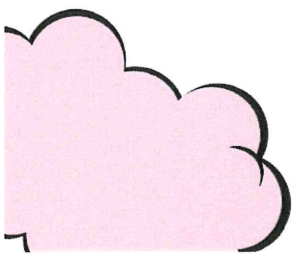
