SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT No. 5-2013

• In accordance with Board Policy AGAB-Recognition for Special Accomplishment:

- Lunan Zhao from École secondaire Kelvin High School will receive funding in the amount of \$790 to support his attendance at the Forum for Young Canadians from March 24-29, 2013 in Ottawa, Ontario.
