New Business

- By-Law No. 1205, a by-law of The Winnipeg School Division for the purpose of permitting religious instruction at Wellington School, was read a third time in short and passed.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT No. 12-2012

• The proper officers of the Division were authorized to enter into an agreement in the amount of \$199,000 with the Manitoba Crime Prevention Branch for the continuation of the CHOICES Youth Program at eight schools (Andrew Mynarski, David Livingstone, Elmwood High, General Wolfe, Gordon Bell High, Hugh John Macdonald, St. John's High and William Whyte

Schools) for a one-year period effective April 1, 2012.
