## COACH 1

Students are registered at Mulvey School and attend at an off-campus site.

COACH 1 serves students from grades 1 – 6 with a focus on social emotional learning, regulation strategies, and early years elementary intervention to promote academic success.

## COACH 2

Students are registered at General Wolfe School and attend at an off-campus site.

COACH 2 serves students from grades 7 – 9 with a focus on supporting students with emotional and behavioural needs, providing strategies and skills for further building student success.

# About COACH

The COACH program is an intensive, year-round community-based and academic program that provides emotional, behavioural and academic wraparound intervention and support for students and their families.

The COACH program supports students who require additional supports and resources to successfully attend school regularly. The goals of COACH are to:

- ✓ Increase frequency of positive behaviours and promote healthy interactions for families and decrease the frequency of negative behaviours on the part of the student.
- ✓ Provide opportunities for students to learn about themselves and promote success in educational and community settings.
- ✓ Help children with emotional and behavioural challenges.
- ✓ Improve social skills and emotional learning.
- ✓ Provide culturally relevant programming.

In partnership with families, we further promote strategies of healthy interactions and a positive approach to appropriate behavioural changes.

# Why COACH?

The COACH program is designed to:

- ✓ Provide social, emotional and educational supports for students in Winnipeg.
- ✓ Provide an off-campus setting to empower students as academic learners while promoting success in community activities.
- ✓ Provide each student with a comprehensive, strength-based wraparound approach.
- ✓ Return the student as soon as possible to a school-based setting where the student is able to succeed.
