Priorities for 2022-2023

Literacy

- Data driven instruction and planning for learning.
- Becoming more proficient with the IBM compass programming and how it can aid assessment and planning.
- Common School Wide Resources/strategies – so that students are familiar with them and that common language is used through the school and grade levels.
- Celebrate student success through events such as literacy lunch, exhibiting student work in the front showcase, I Love to Read Month.

Numeracy

- Modelling and Communicating Strategies, of grade appropriate manipulatives, small groups, sprints, turn and talk/math talks.
- Focus on using classroom data and MB Concept at a Glance sheets to plan for learning for all students and levels in the classroom through PLC time.
- Reintroduce daily math routines in classroom for student success.
- Planning for month/unit with teachers specifically pointing out what manipulative/skill will be used that matches the unit.

Wellness

- To reconnect with the school community and promote pride in our school through food, events, thanksgiving, bbq, etc.
- To build relationships and engagement outside of the classroom through things like assemblies and inviting community members.

Sustainability

- Continue the Gardening Club and Newspaper
- Adding lesson plans to the Outdoor Classroom Bin (Jenny)
- Continue to implement the use of the Garden Walls as Zones for Regulation.
- Have a Dream Catcher themed Garden Wall where student's names and Teachers will be included to the wall.
- Have an ESD led school wide event for Earth Day in April of 2024. (Whole Committee)

Literacy

To continue to develop best literacy practices through:

- Data collecting/data driven instruction and planning for learning.
- Familiarizing and exploring the Manitoba Provincial ELA curriculum across the elementary grade bands
- Common School Wide Resources and use of common language and strategies throughout classrooms.
- Creating language rich environments that give students the opportunity to read, write and share their thinking daily
- Literacy team will continue showcase and celebrate student success through events such as literacy lunch, exhibiting student work in the front showcase, I Love to Read Month.

Numeracy

To continue to develop best numeracy practice through:

- Machray School will focus on teaching problem-solving strategies as part of a daily math routine and/or implement problem solving into big idea exploration.
- All students will be engaged and immersed in grade level curriculum.
- All teachers will assess students using the Manitoba Report Card Grade Scale Mathematics Achievement Profiles.

Education for Sustainable Development

To expand on current Sustainable Development practice through:

- Continue with the Gardening Club and continue with the monthly newsletter.
- Inform the staff on ways to use the Garden walls for regulation as well as for learning.
- Use one of the Garden Walls to showcase our student community.
- Encourage staff to use the outdoor classroom as a space for learning.
- Establish a composting system in the school.
