School Report

- \circ We had a busy first half of the year and semester one is ending at the end of the month
 - We are moving into final assessments with a range of different methods being used
 - No formal exam period this year
- We have added a few new courses to choose from for the 2nd semester giving more options to our students
- Our professional learning groups continue to meet
- Big focus for the division: absenteeism
 - How do we make school more accessible?
 - Looking at ways to create a strong purpose, engagement, and connection
- Focus on Indigenous teachings
 - We had a planetarium set up in the gym and learned about First Nations stories and names for stars and constellations
 - Winter Solstice teachings with the WDS Kookum in December
- What does inclusion mean?
 - o It is very broad
 - Many programs in our schools
 - There has been a big shift in WSD we have a different model than other school divisions
 - there is an ebb and flow between academic and additional supports
- Arts
 - o 42 students out at Camp Assiniboia for a band retreat
 - We continue to fill the walls with student works
 - We received a grant from the Art Association
 - Looking to install an Indigenous focused mural and working with a local artist and our Kookum
 - Mean Girls musical a resounding success
- Sports
 - Basketball, volleyball, and soccer all in full swing
 - Teams led by parent and community coaches with teacher support
 - o Girls hockey team entered into a tournament and will be traveling to Montreal in April
 - Will be forming a boys hockey tournament team to attend same tournament in April
- Open house
 - Scheduled for February 6th
 - Very well attended last year and expecting a good turnout this year as well
 - All feeder schools will have their grade 6's attend in the morning that day
- We had 4 teachers from Collège Belliveau come to talk to us about our Nutrition Program
 - What is our Nutrition Program?
 - We get a grant from Child & Nutrition Council of \$18k to support this initiative
 - We get additional support from Winnipeg Harvest, Cobb Bakery, Second Harvest, and Safeway
 - We provide a breakfast program, a snack program, and a lunch program
 - Anyone and everyone is welcome and food is all made by staff on site

 - Looking ahead to see what the new procedures will be in the WSD as the process is changing when it comes to staffing
