SAFE ARRIVAL

Safe Arrival is the system the school uses to verify student attendance. It's easy to report your child's absence. With SafeArrival, please report your child's absence in advance using any of three convenient methods:

- Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store or from the links at <u>https://go.schoolmessenger.ca</u>).
- Use the SafeArrival website, <u>https://go.schoolmessenger.ca</u>. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account > Select Attendance > then Report an Absence.
- 3. Call the toll-free number 1-855-278-4513 to report an absence the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time.

LUNCH PROGRAM NEWS


