Student Pick Up: Important Info

*Students will be walked outside with their teacher into their pick up and drop off line on the hard top. Parents/guardians and older siblings will pick up students from their designated line. **Please do not double park or stop along Alfred Avenue for pickup. Students will not be dismissed from their line to a parent in a vehicle. This is for safety! Please park, exit your vehicle, and pick up your child from their classroom line. KEEP ME HOME:

Fever

(higher than 38°C or 100° F)

Sore Throat

Persistent Cough

Strep Throat

Vomiting or Diarrhea

Abdominal Pain

(severe or long-lasting)

Illness

(prevents from participating comfortably in activities)

SEND ME TO SCHOOL:

No Fever

(without fever-reducing medicine for 24 hours)

Occasional Cough

(but no other symptoms)

Strep Throat

(after 24 hours of treatment)

No Vomiting or Diarrhea

(for 48 hours)
