

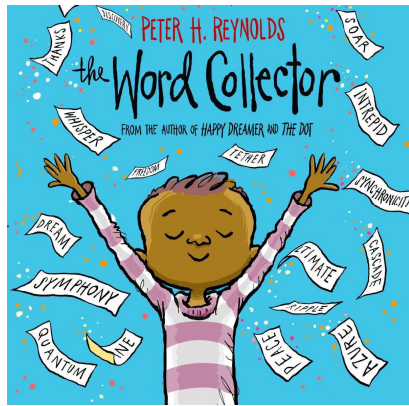

2023 2024 SCHOOL REGISTRATIONS

We are currently accepting new registrations for the 2023-2024 school year. If your child was born in 2019 and you live in the area, your child may qualify for the Nursery program. If your child was born in 2018, they will qualify for the Kindergarten program. Please check out registration forms on our website or visit the school to pick up a copy. We are also accepting for all other grades if your child does not already attend the school. Several documents are needed to complete the registration process: Birth Certificate, MB Health Card, and proof of residency (property assessment, tax bill, mortgage/rental agreement). 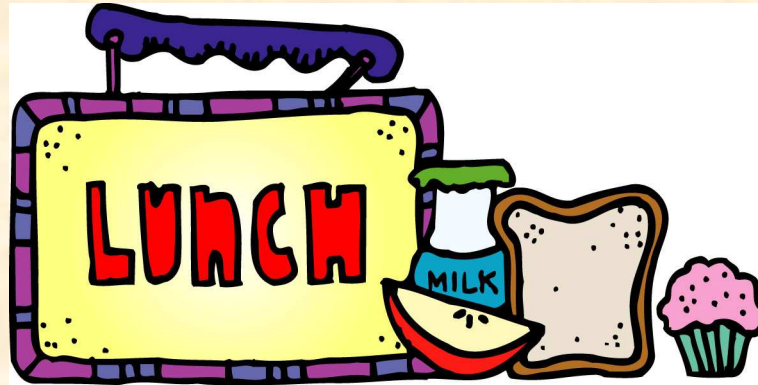

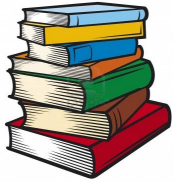

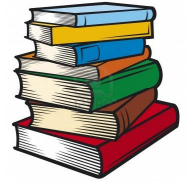
