The grade 9 students researched an Indigenous Hero and shared their knowledge and understanding with their grade 3 buddy.

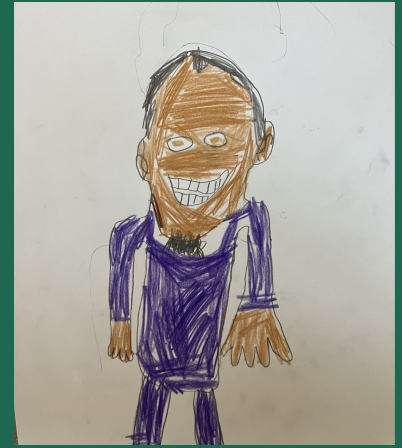

Indigenous Hero

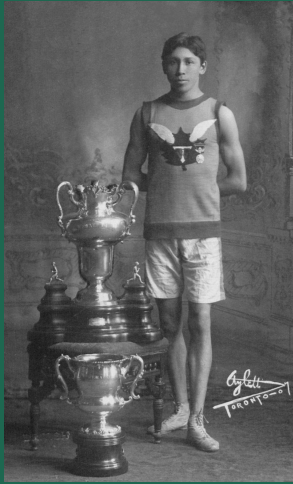


Wab Kinew is a hero

their voice back.

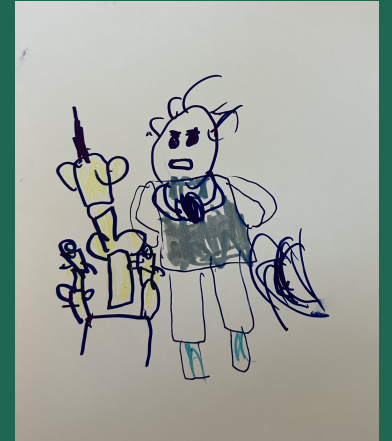


We are people who matter, yes it's true.

Tom Longboat is a hero because he helped in the war by passing down messages.

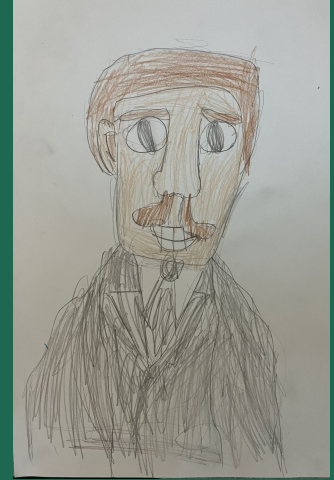

Willard Bolduc is a hero because he was a good man who was strong.

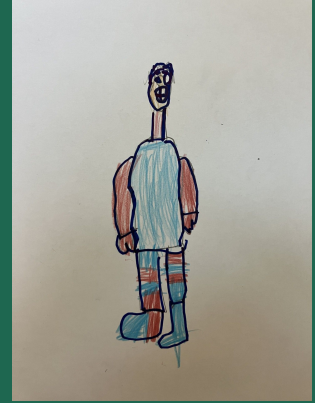

Phyliss Webstad is a hero because she started Orange Shirt Day.

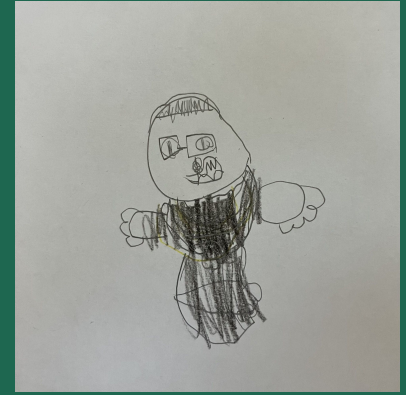

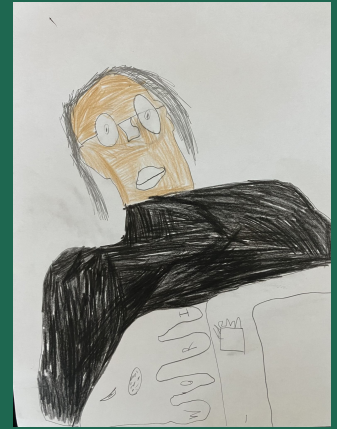
Daphne Odjig is a hero because she addressed the issues of colonization and displacement of Indigenous people.

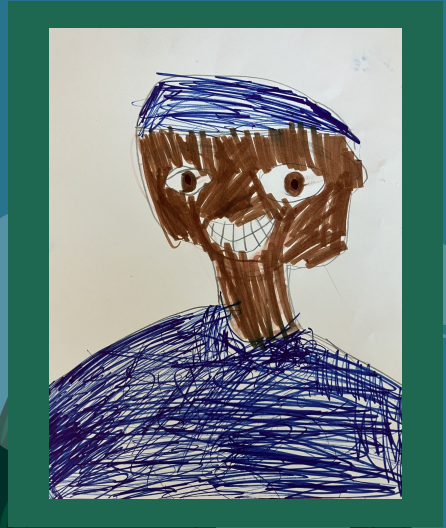

Rebecca Strong is a hero because she inspires people to follow their dreams.

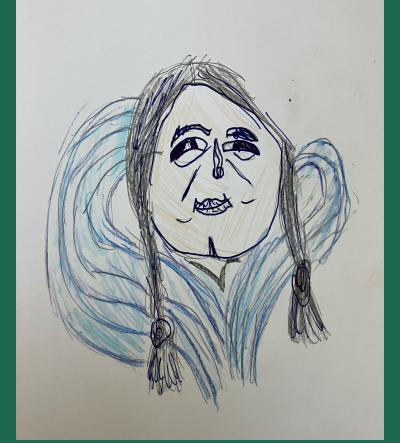
