Full IB students must choose six subjects, one from each of Groups 1 to 5 and the sixth subject may be chosen from Group 6 or a second subject from Group 3 or 4. The combination may be 3 HL and 3 SL or 4 HL and 2 SL courses. Remember that IB Chemistry SL counts as one of your SL courses if you completed it in Grade 11. Partial IB students must take a minimum of two IB courses. Please check off the IB courses in the table below that you want to take.

Note that course codes with a '3' in them are in the Grade 11 course listing online. You will have to switch to the Grade 12 course listing online to find course codes with a '4' in them.
