To: Parents/Guardians/ Grade 12 Students,

Re: January Provincial Grade 12 Exams and Semester 1 Kelvin Exams

Before the semester comes to a close, Kelvin grade 12 students will participate in provincial exams in January 2025. Students enrolled in English, Français (French Immersion) and Mathematics (Applied, Essentials, Precalculus) in semester 1 have been registered for the provincial exams. Provincial exams account for 20% of a student's final grade and the provincial exam result is indicated on report cards and transcripts.

The provincial exam schedule is as follows:

**English Language Arts** Tuesday, January 6th—all morning  
Wed.—Fri., January 7th-9th—one hour each day during English class

**French Language Arts** (French Immersion students only)  
Wednesday, January 7th—one hour during French class  
Monday, January 12th—all morning  
Tuesday, January 13th—all morning

**Mathematics**  
Applied—Tuesday, January 20th—all morning  
Essentials—Wednesday, January 21st—all morning  
Pre-Calculus—Thursday, January 22nd—all morning

Grade 12 ELA, FLA and Math teachers have already begun discussions and preparations for the exams. We expect that students continue to attend classes on a consistent basis to work in their classrooms with their teachers. Engagement and preparation will help prepare students so they are confident and are able to perform to the best of their abilities. Depending on what courses your child is taking and the date(s) of the scheduled provincial exams, your child will be excused from their other non-provincial exam courses. The library is open as a quiet, study area for students.

**Kelvin Exam Week** takes place Monday, January 26th to Friday, January 30th. Grade 12 students taking sciences courses (biology, chemistry and physics) will write these exams in the gymnasium during exam week. There will not be any regular classes at Kelvin during exam week. The library will be open for students to access during exam week for a quiet study space. The cafeteria and its services will be closed. Students are only permitted in the building during their scheduled exams or should they choose to access the study spaces provided.

There is a **school closure** on Monday, February 2nd and **Semester 2** begins on Tuesday, February 3rd.

Outside of regular classroom instruction, Kelvin has additional math support to help our students prepare for exams, develop better understanding of course outcomes and complete assignments.

**Math Resource Center** is available Monday—Friday 12:30—1:10 in Room 41. The Math Resource Center is supported each day by Kelvin Math teachers and trained peer tutors.
