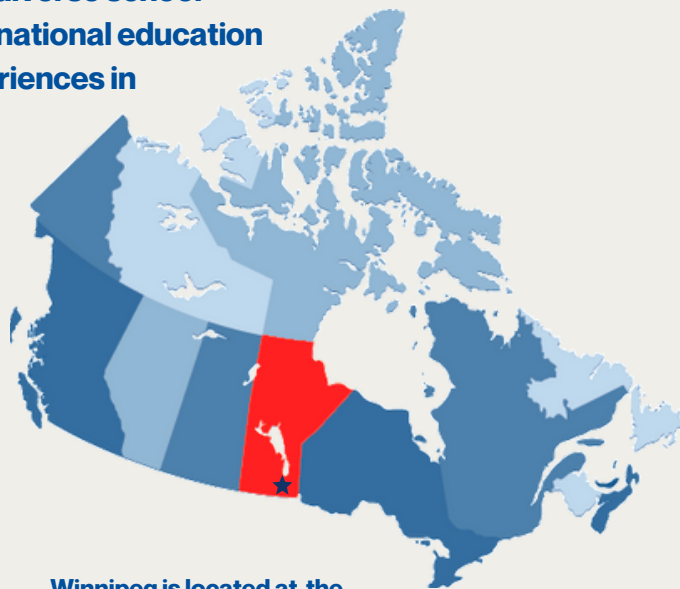

Winnipeg School Division is the largest, most diverse school district in Manitoba, Canada. Winnipeg's international education program offers short or long-term study experiences in English or French at all grade levels.

Students are taught Manitoba Provincial curriculum by government-certified teachers and English language development specialists. Many schools also offer specialized certificate or diploma programs where students complete graduation requirement courses while participating practical, real-world learning and work experiences

High school students may earn course credits toward a Manitoba High School Diploma or a diploma at home. The Manitoba diploma is recognized around the world. Many graduates attend post-secondary education in Canada or abroad.
