Purpose: To provide a trauma informed classroom where students access clinical interventions and appropriate academic programming until such time as they can successfully rejoin their inclusive home school community. All students will have at least one Student Specific Plan.

Supports: Trauma informed classroom and programming alongside academic supports accessing appropriate educational programming for each student. Indigenous and cultural programming, teaming with outside service providers, and other programming to build strategies and self– advocacy in preparation to return to the home school.

Learning behaviours: All students will be included in daily school routines and classes with their same age peers as much as possible for the full school day. Independence is fostered in all environments with the goal of returning to the home school.

English Language Arts

Reading:

- Independent, small group and
 1:1 with teacher.
- Students will be introduced to a variety of genres.
- Reading strategies will be taught, students will make connections to the text they are reading which will strengthen comprehension.

Word Study:

 Words Their Way is word study for Phonics, Vocabulary and Spelling Instruction.

Writing:

- Students will learn to write for a variety of purposes and for different audiences.
- Students will learn the following writing traits: ideas, organization, voice, word choice, sentence fluency and conventions.

Math

- Students will deepen their understanding of mental math strategies, calendar and time, patterns, measurement, shapes, basic operations, number concepts, place value and problem solving skills.
- Hands on activities, Smart-Board activities and math manipulatives will be used.
- Computer programs and applications on the iPad will be used to reinforce skills.

Art

Visual Arts, Drama and Dance will be integrated across the curriculum.
