

The school division follows the temperature at the Forks on the Government of Canada weather website. You can access this directly by going to the Winnipeg School Division website and clicking on "current temp".

Patrol Guidelines for Cold Weather

We appreciate the service and responsibility that our students take on as patrols for our school. This is especially evident when patrols are on duty during the cold winter months. The guidelines for patrols in cold weather are as follows:

Patrols will do normal duty schedule up to and including temperatures of -27°C. When the weather becomes colder than this (-28°C to -34°C), they will have considerably shorter times on post (5 minutes or less). When it is -35°C or colder, no patrols will be on duty.

Please help ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for patrol duty during these cold months.

Parking Safety Reminder

This is a reminder to our Nursery and Kindergarten parents to please park your vehicles on Rathgar or Beresford and WALK your child to the courtyard doors at entry and dismissal times. Many vehicles are parking or idling in the back lane causing serious safety concerns.
