Mcphillips to the backlane; there is NO parking or stopping in this area from 3:00-4:00 p.m. daily. Instead, please pick your child up at the opening in the fence at the "STOP, DROP and GO" sign on Aberdeen Avenue, where it is safe for them to enter/exit on the curb side. Thank you for your continued cooperation in working to keep our children safe on the icy streets!

It is very important that your children are dressed appropriately for the weather. January is a very cold month! Students will continue to go outside for two 15 minute and lunch recess periods in order to continue to stimulate their brains with fresh air and their bodies with physical activity. If the temperature and wind chill are below -27° C, students will stay inside.
