To: Parents/Guardians/Students,

Re: Semester 1 January Exams and Preparations

Kelvin students will be participating in exams during the week of January 26th to January 30th, 2026. Grade 10, 11 and 12 students will be writing their exams in the school gymnasium, while Grade 9 will be writing exams in their classrooms. Only compulsory subjects will be written during the exam week. The assessment of non-compulsory courses will take place prior to exam week. Students in our International Baccalaureate Program will be writing exams in the cafeteria following IB program guidelines.

There will not be any regular classes at Kelvin during exam week. The library will be open for students to access during exam week for a quiet study space. The cafeteria and its services will be closed. Students are only permitted in the building during their scheduled exams or should they choose to access the study spaces provided.

An exam make-up opportunity is scheduled on January 30th. This is an accommodation for any student who has missed their scheduled exam. Students will be required to provide supporting medical documentation in the case of a missed exam that was not pre-arranged.

We expect that students continue to attend classes on a consistent basis prior to exam week, to complete daily/weekly assignments and to work in their classrooms on exam reviews with their teachers. Engagement, preparation and attendance will help prepare students so they are able to perform to the best of their abilities.

Outside of regular classroom instruction, students are encouraged to arrange additional support with their teachers if they have questions or need more instruction about a topic or concept prior to the exams. As throughout the semester, Kelvin has additional math support to help our students, to complete assignments, and to develop a better understanding of math outcomes. Grade 12 Mentors are also offering an exam study hall to Grade 9 students January 12-23th over the lunch hour in room 56 for all courses.

A reminder for families: Exams are just one part of how students are assessed at Kelvin. Throughout each course, teachers use a variety of assessments—including assignments, projects, labs, presentations, in-class tasks, and ongoing learning checks—to build a comprehensive understanding of student learning. Exam results are considered alongside all other evidence to reflect each student's overall achievement.
