Lunch Program Registration for 2025-2026

Our school, along with most schools in the Winnipeg School Division, will be implementing a **no-fee supervision lunch program**. This means that our students will have access to a supervised lunch hour at school each day, completely free of charge.



You won't need to complete any formal registration forms for your child to participate in this program. We will simply need to know if your child will be staying at school for lunch or going home. A form will be sent home on the first day of school in September for you to indicate your child's lunch plans. Please return this form by Friday, September 5, 2025.

Please remember that staying at school for lunch remains a privilege. We expect all students to demonstrate respectful and appropriate behaviour during the lunch hour. **Ongoing or repeated inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated.** Our dedicated Educational Assistants (EAs) will continue to supervise students during this time to ensure a safe and positive environment for everyone.

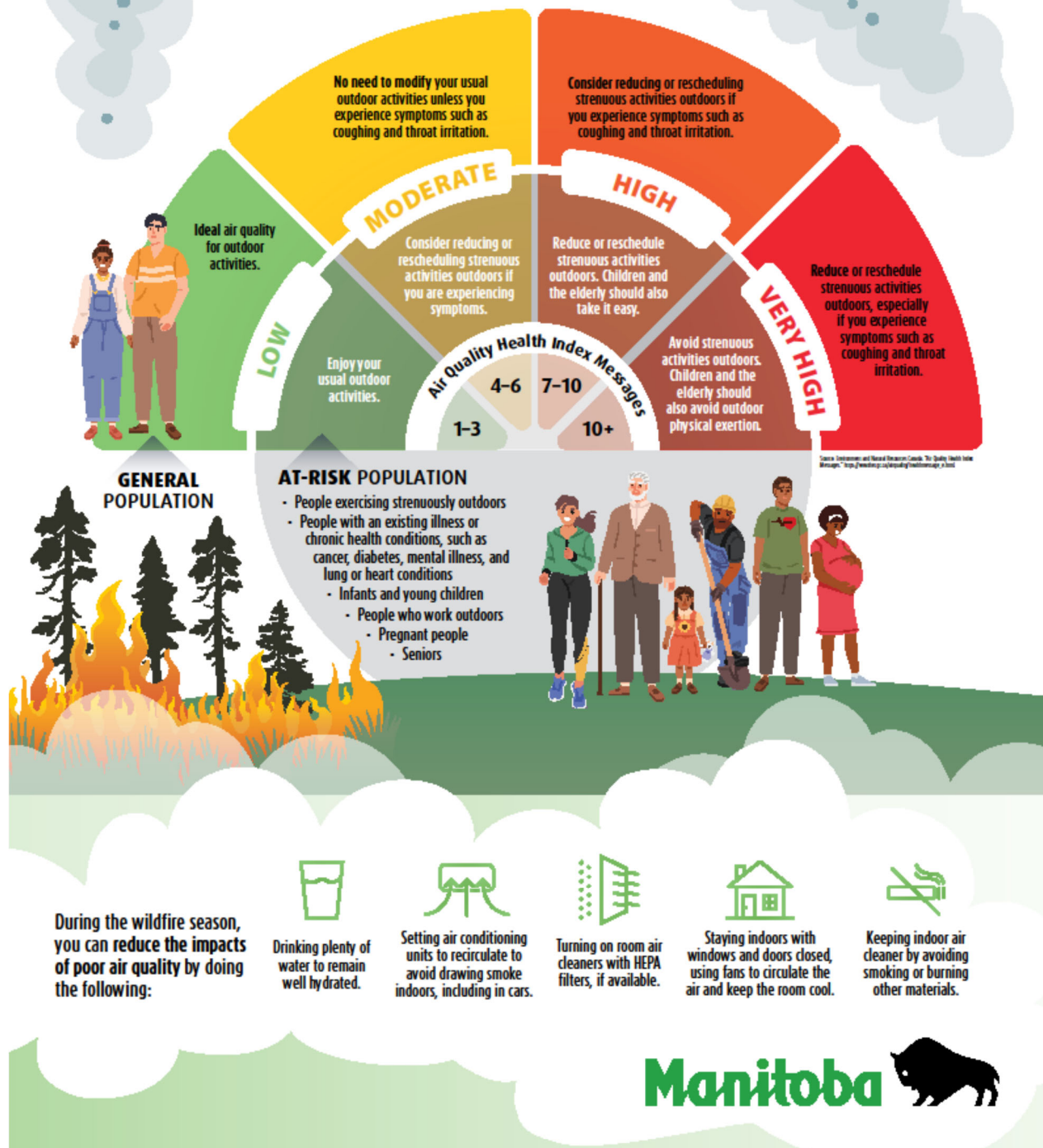


Air Quality and You

French movies:

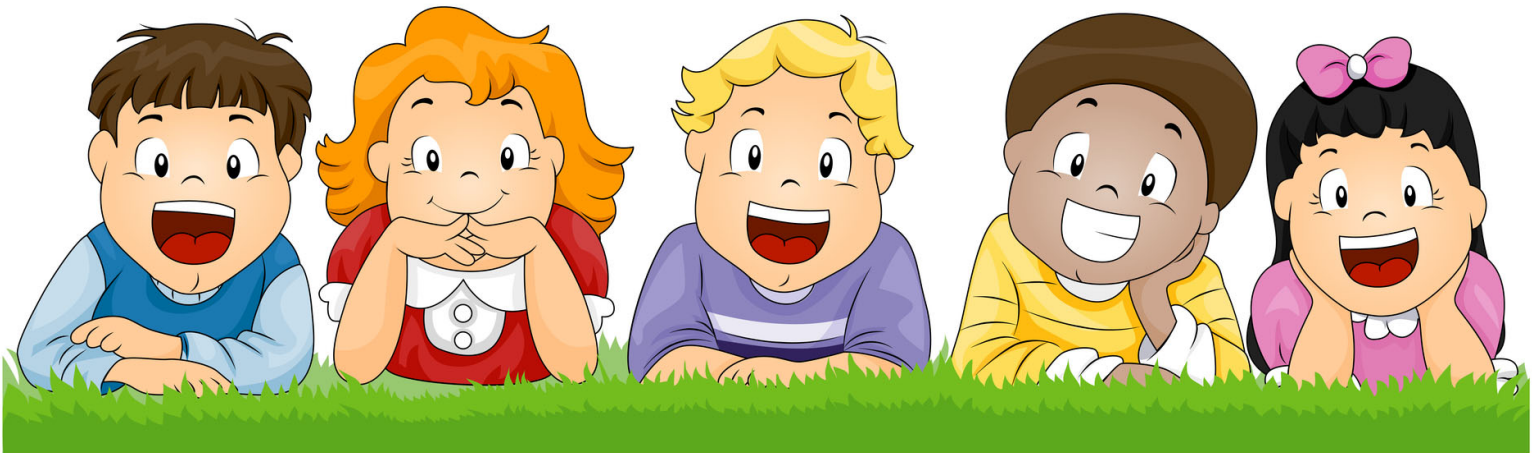
- Watch a favourite movie in French. Every DVD produced for Canadian distribution comes with both English and French audio tracks and subtitles.
