






STUDENTS TURNING 18 YEARS OF AGE

Parents are reminded that once a student turns 18, we require a waiver signed by the student to enable us to provide information to parents regarding the learning of the student.

Waivers are mailed home the month before the student turns 18. Please talk to your child about this requirement before their 18th birthday.

SAFE ARRIVAL

To enhance our existing absence-checking procedure, Tec-Voc is using a student absence reporting system called Safe Arrival. Safe Arrival will make it easy for you to report your child's absence.

Parents/Guardians are asked to report their child(rens) absence in advance using any of these 3 methods:

- Using your cell phone, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Use the SafeArrival website, <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Call the toll-free number 1-855-278-4513 to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

Register for Summer Driver Z!

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to announce that registration for MPI's summer Driver Z courses will begin at 8:00 a.m. on May 28, 2025. A listing of all available summer courses will be published on May 23, 2025, on [our Course Finder page](#).

- Each course will consist of two weeks of virtual classes and three weeks of in-car lessons.
- Due to the condensed course delivery, students must attend all classes with no exceptions. This applies to both the virtual classes and in-car lessons.
- Virtual classes will be held between 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (see the schedules at [Summer Driver Z Courses](#) for exact times).

Resources and Registration Information:

This program is designed to equip young drivers with the essential skills and knowledge needed for safe and responsible driving. MPI's experienced instructors will provide a supportive and engaging learning environment to help students gain confidence on the road.

Complete these steps to sign up for one of the available summer courses in your community:

1. Review the schedule and confirm that your student can fully commit to attending all classes and important dates.
2. Attend a broker or MPI Service Centre before May 28, 2025, to:
 - Be set up as a customer. To get set up as a customer, you will need to bring identification. Use our [Proving My Identity tool](#) to find the documents you need when you attend.
 - Purchase the Driver Z service (\$50.00).
3. Register for a Driver Z summer course beginning at 8:00 a.m. on May 28, 2025, by choosing one of the following options:
 - Attending your broker's office (parent/guardian and student must attend)
 - Attending an MPI Service Centre (parent/guardian and student must attend)
 - Calling MPI's Contact Centre at 204-985-7000 or toll-free 1-800-665-2410 (parent/guardian and student must be on the phone)
 - Calling MPI's Driver Education office directly (student or parent/guardian) at 204-985-7199 or toll-free at 1-800-261-9928 (Please note: this office opens at 8:30 a.m.)
