STUDENTS TURNING 18 YEARS OF AGE

Parents are reminded that once a student turns 18, we require a waiver signed by the student to enable us to provide information to parents regarding the learning of the student. Waivers are mailed home the month before the student turns 18. Please talk to your child about this requirement before their 18th birthday.

SAFE ARRIVAL

To enhance our existing absence-checking procedure, Tec-Voc is using a student absence reporting system called Safe Arrival. Safe Arrival will make it easy for you to report your child's absence. Parents/Guardians are asked to report their child(rens) absence in advance using any of these 3 methods:

- Using your cell phone, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Use the SafeArrival website, <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Call the toll-free number 1-855-278-4513 to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time.

Tec-Voc Student Exam Regulations and Responsibilities:

- It is the student responsibility to know the date, time and location of their exams.
- Students should arrive **10 minutes before** the exam is scheduled to start .
- Students should have **only the required supplies** – pens, pencils, eraser, ruler, calculator (if required), etc.
- Cell phones cannot be used during exams and cannot be used as calculators .
- All cell phones must be turned off before exams begin.
- Do not bring music or gaming devices to the exam. Headphones are not allowed during exams.
- All jackets, bags, non-essential items must be placed at the front of the exam room .
- Students must wait for all instructions before beginning the exam .
- Students must speak to teachers **as soon as possible** to resolve any exam schedule conflicts.
- Students that are not scheduled for an exam or in scheduled assessment must **not be loitering in the hallways**. Students may choose to study in the **library, cafeteria, or at home**.
- All students must remain in the exam room for **minimum 1 hour**.
