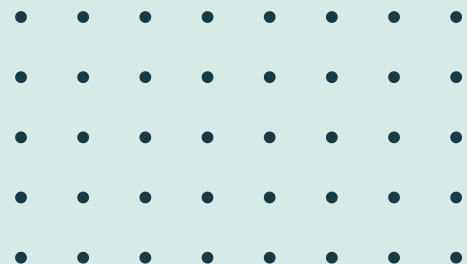

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

École George V will once again use a prepaid system for grade appropriate school supplies for the 2025-2026 academic year. Your child's teacher will purchase all necessary school supplies for the entire school year. This has proven to be successful in our school as well as in many schools in the division. The system ensures that all students are equipped with the same, necessary supplies. Following are the amounts requested per student for the various grade levels:

Nursery & Kindergarten	\$25.00
Grades 1 – 8	\$40.00

Payment for school supplies will be due to child's classroom teacher before Friday, September 26, 2025.

Please place cash in a sealed envelope with your child's name and hand it directly to the classroom teacher, or, if your are paying with cheque, please make it out to École George V School.

The following are examples of supplies purchased for our classroom:

Pencils, Pens, Erasers, Pencil sharpeners, Pencil cases, Rulers, Scissors, Markers, Pencil crayons, Wax crayons, Sharpies, Highlighters, Liquid glue, Glue sticks, Lined paper, Duotangs, Notebooks, Dictionaries, Labels, Tissues, Communication bags, Art supplies and subject related materials necessary for experiments and projects.
