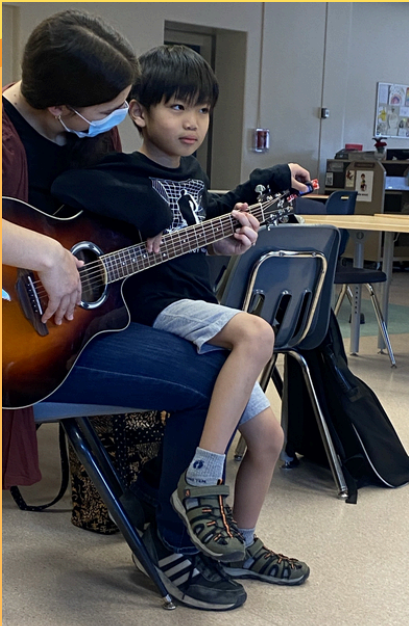
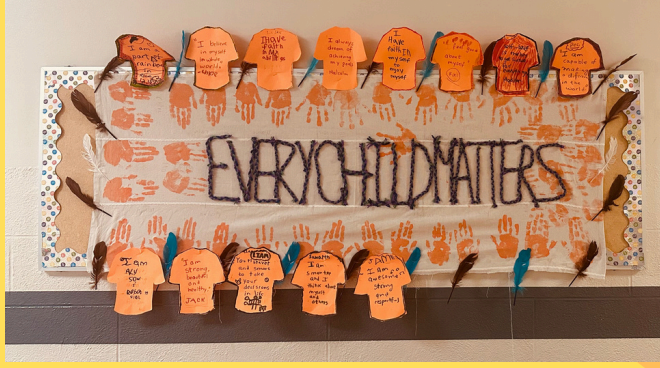
Through this funding, we've been able to support a wide range of learning experiences throughout the year, including:
