## **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT NO. 3-2018**

The proper officers of WSD were authorized, subject to Public Schools Finance Board approval, to enter into a contract with Loewen Mechanical Ltd. to supply all material and perform all work in connection with the Steam Heating System Replacement project at Brock Corydon School.

The proper officers of WSD were authorized to enter into a contract with More-Lite Electric Ltd. to supply all material and perform all work in connection with the fire alarm system upgrade project at Isaac Newton School.

The proper officers of WSD were authorized to enter into a contract with AAA Electric 1988 Ltd. to supply all material and perform all work in connection with the generator upgrade 2018 project at Sisler High School.

c) That schools purchase back-up epinephrine auto-injectors for those students/staff who have a prescription based on student ratio for the 2018/2019 school year.

The motion was passed that the Division purchase Land Recognition Plaques to be displayed in all Winnipeg School Division schools.

The motion was passed that the revised Policy AD-Educational Philosophy be approved.
