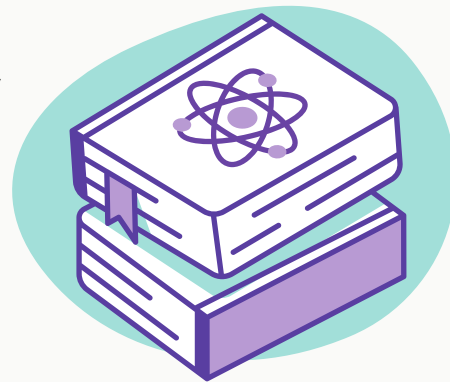
Science Expo

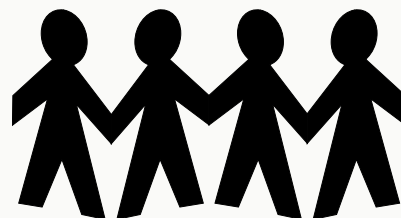

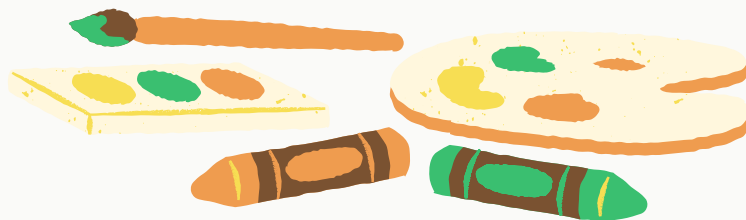
