Registrations for School Year 2023 2024

We are now accepting registrations for all grades for September 2023 2024!

If you are a resident of the Winnipeg School Division:

***NURSERY (CHILD BORN IN 2019) or KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM (CHILD BORN IN 2018):** There is no fee if you live within the division. There are several forms that you will need to fill out as well as various documents you will need to provide (Please see checklist on our school website)

***GRADE 1-GRADE 6 (No Fee):** Same documents as above

If you are NOT a resident of the Winnipeg School Division:

***NURSERY PROGRAM (FEE):** You will be required to fill out several forms and provide documentation as well as pay the fee of \$590.00 (per month) (subject to change) for the school year.

***KINDERGARTEN-GRADE 6 (No Fee):** You will need to fill out the forms and provide the documentation as well as fill out a Non-Resident Form

ALL REGISTRATIONS ARE BASED ON APPROVAL BY PRINCIPAL

If your child attends Tyndall Park School:

***NURSERY-GRADE 6:** Students will be automatically preregistered for next year at the same school

If your child will be changing schools:

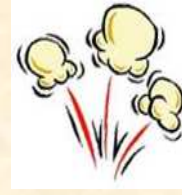

Winnipeg Humane Society in Room 6

We all know of the Winnipeg Humane Society and the good work they do in helping find adoptive homes for animals and reuniting lost pets with their owners. They also run a school visit program called 'Empathy for All Living Things'. Room 6 will be participating in the program throughout the month of March. Through interactive activities and meaningful conversations, the series designed by teachers and animal welfare specialists hope to teach students to have a responsible, empathetic attitude towards all living things.

The four sessions in room 6 will run March 1, 3, 7, and 9 during the school day for 45 minutes sessions each day. The topics they will focus on are Basic and Emotional Needs, Conflict, Stress & Emotion and Loss & Grief.



Swimming Counts Program Grade 4s



Swimming Counts! runs in partnership between the City of Winnipeg and the Winnipeg School Division. The program focuses on water safety education, and consists of four sessions in total (one at the students' school and three at the St. James Civic Centre pool. This valuable program offers three skill levels to accommodate students' abilities. Students will learn Water Safety Skills in hopes they are better prepared when near water locations.

Grade 4 students who are participating will be bussed to the pool over the noon hour and will be returning by 2pm. Students will have already attended one session in February and on March 7th & 14th.

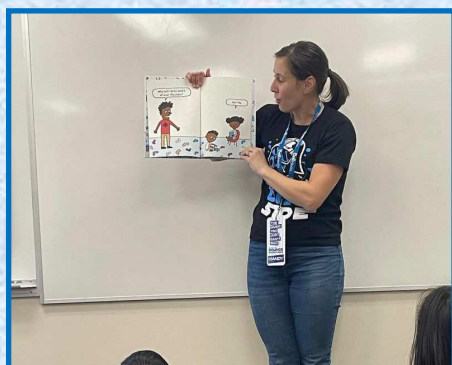

We would like to give a huge **THANK YOU** to all our guest readers who took the time to visit Tyndall Park School and share with students their favourite stories.



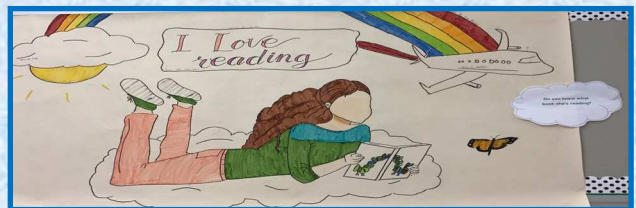
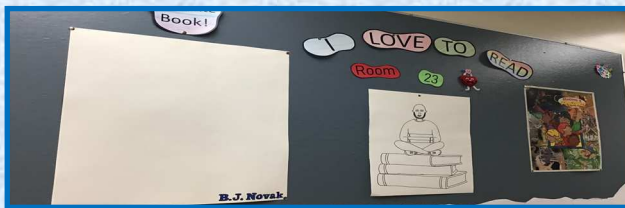
Guess what

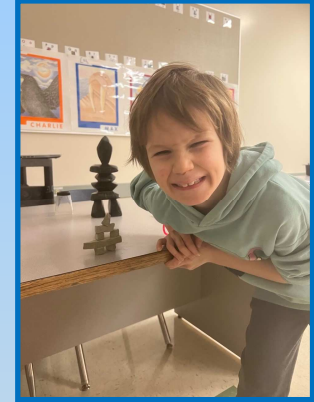

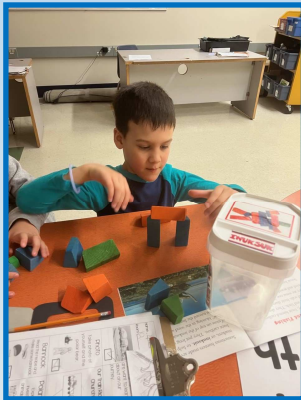

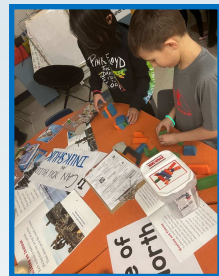

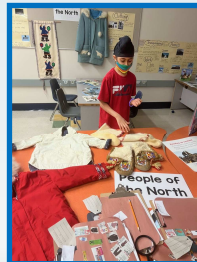
