Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Tyndall Park Lunch Program would love to have your child/ren join us here for lunch for the school year 2023-2024. In order to better prepare ourselves, the lunch program is asking **all families with a remaining balance still owing for the current school year to have all fees paid in full by April 20, 2023**. We need to know where we sit financially so we can move forward with staffing and scheduling.

We have two **early registration dates** for you to attend in person.

The first date is: **Thursday, May 4th, 2023 3:30 to 6:30 p.m.**

The second date is: **Tuesday, June 6th, 2023 5:00 to 8:00 p.m.**

After serious consideration and meetings with the other Lunch Program supervisors in our surrounding area, it brings me pleasure to announce that the Lunch Program fee for 2023-2024 school year will remain the same for the students of Tyndall Park Community School, while the other schools decided on an increase.

Student enrollment into the Lunch Program for 2023-2024 will only be accepted after registration is completed and paid in full.

Payment options are:

- 1) **E-transfer** or **cash**, one payment made for full amount of **\$260**, or
- 2) by **cheque**, with one cheque written for full amount of **\$260** or
10 individual cheques in the amount of **\$26**, post-dated for the first of each month.

Cheques should be made payable to Tyndall Park Lunch Program. E-transfers will not be accepted for the monthly payment option.

Families will have until **Monday, June 19, 2023** to register your child/ren for the next school year. After June 19th, anyone registering for the Lunch Program will be charged a **\$25.00 late fee**.

If you are a resident of the Winnipeg School Division:

***NURSERY/KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM (No Fee):** There are several forms that you will need to fill out as well as various documents you will need to provide (Please see checklist on our school website)

***GRADE 1-GRADE 6 (No Fee):** Same as above

If you are NOT a resident of the Winnipeg School Division:

***NURSERY PROGRAM (FEE):** You will be required to fill out several forms and provide documentation as well as pay the fee of \$5900.00 (subject to change) for the school year

***KINDERGARTEN-GRADE 6 (No Fee):** You will need to fill out the forms and provide the documentation as well as fill out a Non-Resident Form

ALL REGISTRATIONS ARE BASED ON APPROVAL BY PRINCIPAL

If your child attends Tyndall Park School:

***NURSERY-GRADE 5:** Students will be automatically preregistered for next year at the same school

If your child will be changing schools:

Please inform the office immediately if you are planning on changing schools. You will need to fill out registration forms at the forwarding school. Students in Grade 6 will have received forms from Stanley Knowles School in the Spring.

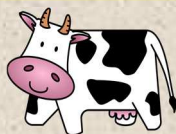
Grade 3s Learn About Farming



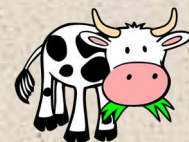

Grades 1-4 Spring Concert

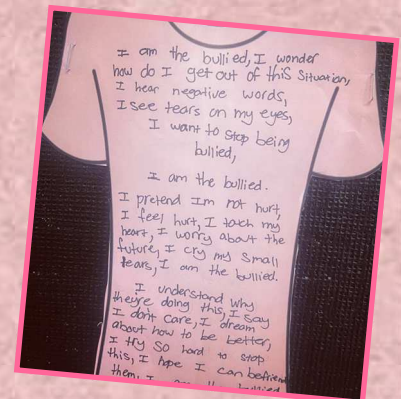
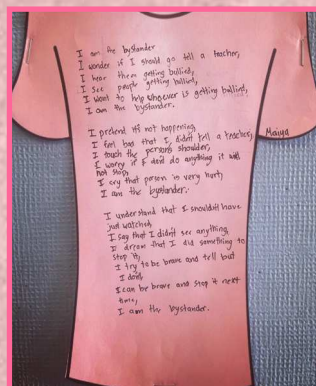
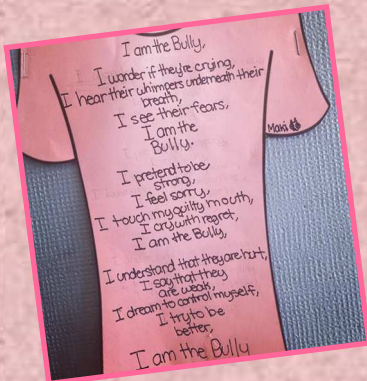
