As we begin to plan for next year, we are compiling information to use in the class formation process. Great care and consideration goes into the make-up of all classrooms in consultation with our classroom teachers. Our classroom teachers know the students well and have school-based knowledge about the following criteria: class size, social dynamics, academics, friendships and parent information. We rely on the professional judgements of our teachers to assist us with the process of determining class makeup for the 2023-2024 school year. The classroom placement information will be part of the final report card, which will be sent home on June 26. The final decision on student placement will be made by school administration, based on the best interests of all our students.

We continue to accept registrations for the 2023-2024 school year for nursery - grade 6. Children who will be 4 years of age by December 31, 2023 are eligible for the Nursery Program.

Children who will be 5 years of age by December 31, 2023 are eligible for the Kindergarten Program.
