- Create your design on 8.5" x 11" paper
- Designs can be full colour, one colour, or a simple sketch (full colour is not required, as this can be added later with the graphic designer)
- Designs may include words such as our school name or "Grizzlies", but this is not required
- Keep designs clear, bold, and easy to recognize at different sizes
- Ensure your design is school-appropriate and reflects ÉGVS values and/or a Grizzly mascot

## Submission Deadline:

Please submit your design to your classroom teacher by May 20th.

When submitting your design, please be sure to include your **First and Last Name, Grade, and Room Number** on the back of the design.

## Selection Process:

A selection committee made up of school staff, divisional staff, and PAC members will narrow submissions down to the top 5 designs.

Students will also have a voice in the process, helping review the top designs and providing input in selecting the final winning logo.

The winning designer will have the opportunity to work with a divisional graphic designer to refine their logo, making it print-ready and bringing the vision to life for our school community.

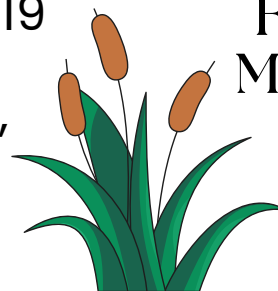

Students in rooms 112 and 119 will be exploring Oak Hammock Marsh on Friday, May 15<sup>th</sup>.

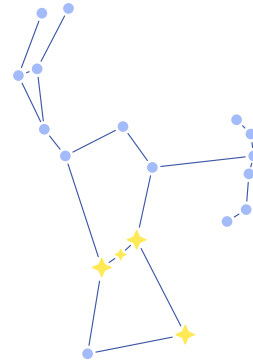

The 4-6 classes all had successful trips to the Concert Hall to see the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra, as part of an Olympic themed unit looking at music from around the world.

## Upcoming in May:

There are several music events coming up in May for George V students:

- On **May 7th** we have a few band students attending the **WSD Band festival**. Students from each WSD school are coming together for the day to learn four or five band pieces, have sectional rehearsals and a late afternoon concert.
- On **May 14th** a few **Grade 5** students are attending **Manitoba Orff's Children's Day** at the **University of Manitoba**. Students will have workshops with drumming, movement, recorder and xylophone during the day, finishing with a late afternoon concert.
