NURSERY AND KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATIONS

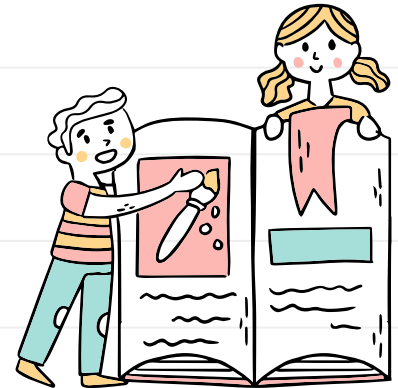
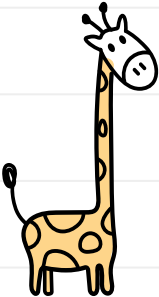
Registrations for Nursery and Kindergarten are now being accepted for the 2024- 2025 School Year!

Our Nursery Program is FREE to all students who are residents of the Winnipeg School Division. Residency is based on where the legal guardian resides.

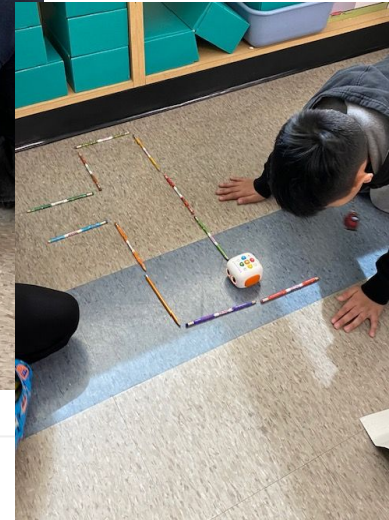
Documents required to register are:

- Proof of Address, either your rental agreement or property tax statement.



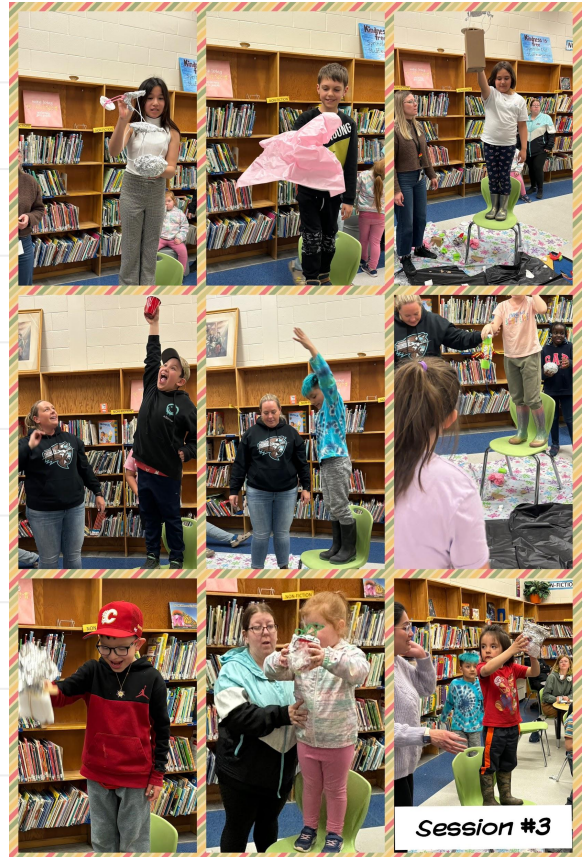
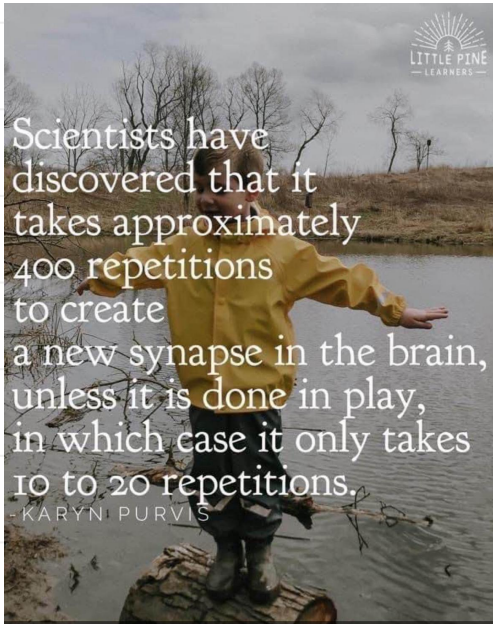
CODING IN THE CLASSROOM...

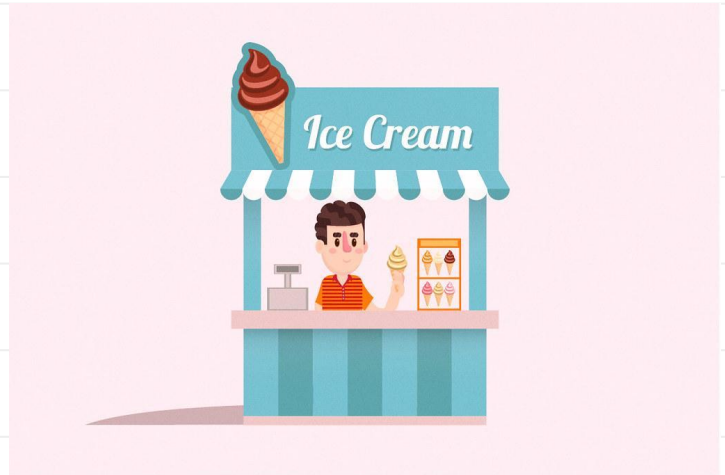

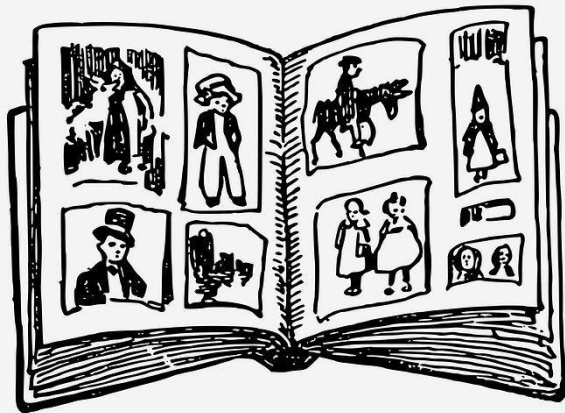
