School Remembrance Service

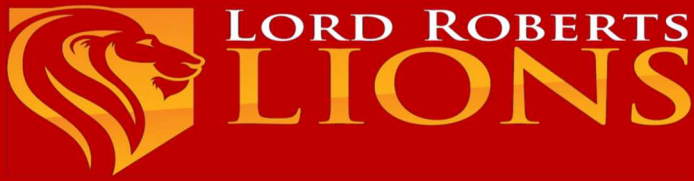
The school will hold a Remembrance Service on November 10th at 11:00 a.m. in the upper gym. Families are welcome to attend.

Parking Safety Reminder

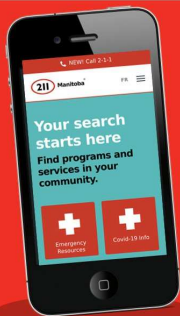
When dropping students off at school please park your vehicles on Rathgar or Beresford and WALK your child to the school property at entry and dismissal times. Many vehicles are parking or idling in the back lane causing serious safety concerns.

Parking spots in the parking lot are assigned for staff use only and should not be used for drop off/pick up purposes. This is especially concerning during the 12:45 lunch time as staff are trying to enter or leave the parking lot but vehicles are double parked or children are moving from the lane to the doors.

For those families who are dropping children off at daycare in the morning via the bus loop, please do not block the sidewalk. If you need to go into daycare please park your car on the road.
