"In collaboration with many local resource centres, Argyle is hosting an Access Fair on Thursday, November 23rd from 5-8pm. This is on the same night as Parent Teacher's Conference, so we welcome all students and guardians/loved ones to attend! This Access Fair will help to connect our students and community members to local resources such as community health care, housing assistance, employment preparation, mental health support and more. There will also be resources at the fair providing direct services, such as financial institutions (to help set up bank accounts, RESPs, Canada Learning Bond, etc.) income tax-filing help, and finally some organizations helping set us up with certain forms of identification. You can see the following letter to learn a bit more about the Canada Learning Bond, which is an important part of the Access Fair. This is a really great opportunity to make sure we are all aware of who in our community is here to help us and how we can access those resources; we encourage you all to attend!"







Dear Families,

Are you or your child born in or after 2004? Are you or your child coming from a lowmoderate income family? You could be eligible to receive the Canada Learning Bond by opening a Registered Education Saving Plan (RESP)

You or your child can use this money to help pay for an apprenticeship program, university, trade school, or college. You can also use the Canada Learning Bond to pay for expenses like tuition, books, tools, rent, or transportation.

You do not have to pay any money into the RESP to receive the **Canada Learning** Bond.

### **Canada Learning Bond Sign-up Event**

Community Financial Counselling Services, Youth Employment Services, and SEED Winnipeg are hosting an RESP sign-up event at 30 Argyle St, Winnipeg. Open a free RESP and access the Canada Learning Bond for your child.

You will need a Social Insurance Number (SIN). If you need a SIN, Service Canada will be present at the event to print out your SIN.

#### Our services at the event:

- Helping you get your Social Insurance Number and birth certificate (at no cost)
- Helping you apply for a no-cost RESP for you or your child and access the Canada Learning Bond

If you open the RESP and apply for the Canada Learning Bond, you will receive a \$100 incentive from us! This incentive is for new RESPs opened prior to Dec. 31, 2023.
