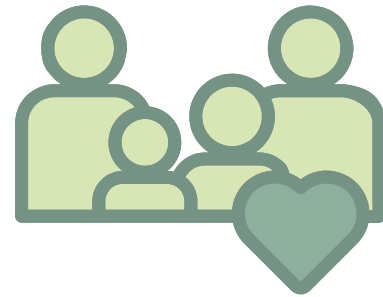

Phys-Ed Updates From Mr. Melnyk

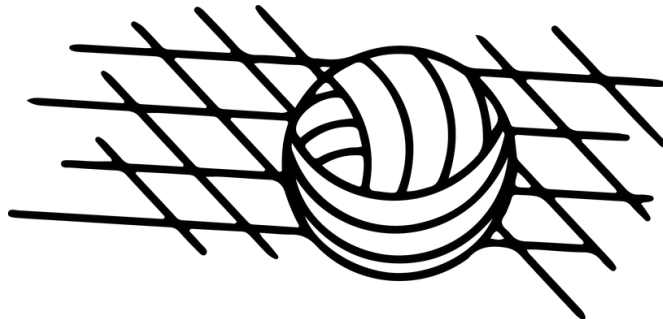
We've been hard at work in the gym learning our fundamental movement skills.

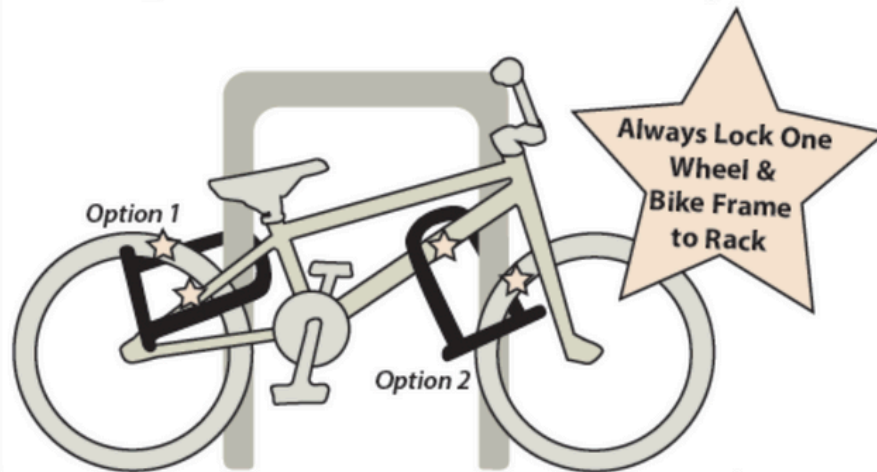
