On Friday, October 24, the students in Rooms 137 and 139 participated in a Community Walk in memory of Chanie Wenjack. As part of our commitment to the Downie Wenjack Legacy, we were learning about Chanie Wenjack and Residential Schools during Secret Path Week, October 17 to 22. Our Act of ReconciliAction, walking the path that Chanie walked, took us to Academy Road. We visited the site of the Assiniboia Residential School Memorial at 621 Academy Road. The Memorial consists of 28 markers, in the colours and shape of the medicine wheel, that name 83 Indigenous Communities, as well as paving stones carved with the names of all the students who attended the Assiniboia Residential School. We also visited the location of the school, that is still standing at 615 Academy Road.


