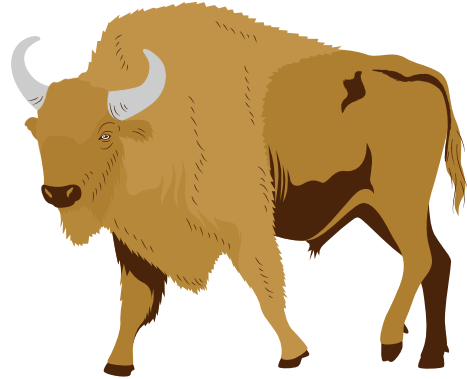

We will be practicing our bus safety starting at 9:30 a.m. to get ready for field trips.

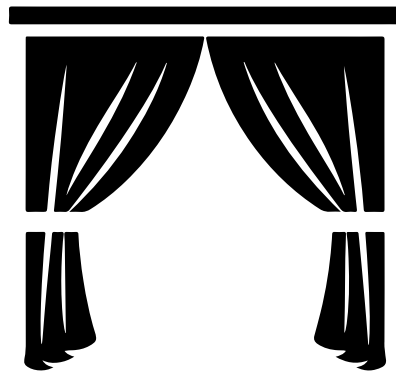

Nursery to Gr 3 students will participate in a costume parade in the Gym at 10:45 a.m.

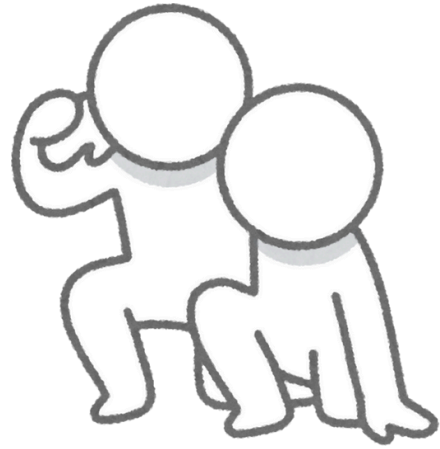
Gr 4-8 students will participate in a costume parade in the Gym at 1:15 p.m.

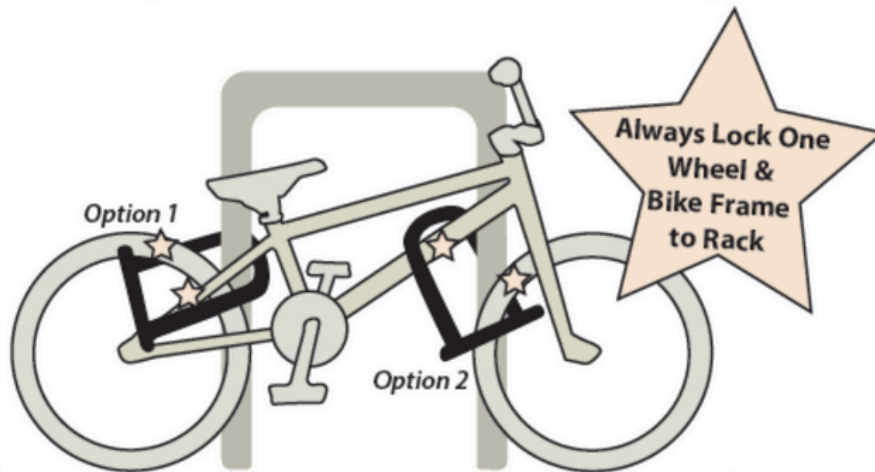
