No Fee Lunch Hour Family Guide (Grades 1–8)

We are happy to offer a No Fee Lunch Hour. Our goal is to provide a safe, caring, and enjoyable space for all students.

Family Choice

Families are asked to complete and sign a Permission Click form for each child, indicating whether your child will:

Stay at school for lunch, or go home for lunch.

Please note: If the Permission Click form is not completed for your child(ren), they may not be eligible to stay for the No Fee Lunch Break. If you require a paper copy of the form, please contact the school office. The link was emailed to you earlier this month.

Changes to Routine

If your child's lunch routine changes, please let the school office and classroom teacher know by 2:30 PM the school day before. This helps us plan for supervision and ensures we can safely account for all students. If your child usually stays but will be going home, or usually goes home but will be staying, advance notice allows us to keep everyone safe and organized.

Students Returning From Lunch at Home

To maintain safe supervision levels, students returning from lunch at home should arrive no earlier than 12:45 PM. If your child needs to return earlier than this time, please notify the school by 2:30 PM the school day before.

Lunch Hour Expectations

Students whose routine includes staying for the No Fee Lunch Hour must remain on school property, unless both the school office and classroom teacher have been notified by 2:30 PM the school day before. Lunch break follows school and division guiding principles: Be Safe, Be Kind, Be Respectful. All students are expected to follow the WSD Student Code of Conduct, the same expectations as during the school day. Students bring their own lunch, containers, and utensils. Please note: microwaves are not available. Everyone helps keep our school welcoming by cleaning up after themselves.

Recess & Weather

Weather permitting, students go outdoors after lunch. Please ensure your child has season-appropriate clothing. If students are unable to go outdoors, they will remain in their classrooms and participate in quiet games or appropriate indoor recess activities.

Working Together

Our goal is for every child to have a positive No Fee Lunch Break experience. If challenges arise and a student has difficulty meeting lunch break expectations, staff will connect with families to provide support and solutions. In some cases, and always in partnership with families, it may be decided that a child takes a short break from staying for lunch at school until they are ready to return successfully.

- Hand washing and hand sanitizer
- Support calm transitions in/out of the room help students
- Encourage students to stay seated while eating
- Remind peers to clean up after themselves
- Help sweep or wipe tables if needed
- · Report any major concerns to an adult

- Ask for help if you need it

Room 123 Highlights


