Approval of Agenda:

Treasurer's Report:

- Proceeds from fundraisers from May/June 2025 (Kernels Popcorn).
- Expenses included:
 - \$500 for Grade 6 farewell
 - \$1,508 for ongoing library shelf replacement fundraiser
 - Service fees
 - Ending balance: \$236.15
- Residual funds kept to cover fees and babysitting.
- CRA correspondence still pending from 2022; PAC received a cheque from lunch program over payment \$831.
- Discussion on whether to close the dormant Lunch Program account (currently ~\$8).
- Action: Jo Ann K. to follow up with Colleen regarding CRA matter.

Principal's Report:

• In the classroom: Belonging & Executive Functioning. Students self-assessing strengths/challenges; teachers implementing strategies per student by end of October.

- Truth & Reconciliation Commemoration (Sept 29): Neighbourhood walk, story in gym, conversation and snack of pemmican.
- Division PD Day (Oct 8): NO CLASS. All WSD staff to attended a joint learning session.
- New School Secretary: Starting Oct 1.
- Road Construction: Sargent Ave expected to conclude near end of September. Adult patrol leaders are supporting this location.
- Road Safety: Crosswalk at Wellington Avenue and Clifton Street has been noted for speeds and lack of vehicle compliance. Have added adult patrol at this location. Police contacted; Councillor Gilroy engaged; possibility of crosswalk lights discussed.
