## ADVISORY



In the Big Picture school design, each student is paired with an Advisor (teacher) who they stay with from enrollment to graduation. Advisors meet daily with this small group of students (15-23 students) to build community and facilitate learning. Advisors also plan projects with the students.

Advisors build strong relationships with caregivers and are their primary point of contact

## PROJECT BASED LEARNING

Students and advisors plan cross curricular projects to address the learning outcomes of the Manitoba curriculum. Students are actively engaged in relevant real world projects that allow for deeper learning



## COMMUNITY BASED LEARNING (L2L)



Every Wednesday, students leave the school to learn. We recognize and acknowledge that learning takes place all around us. Through these unique real world learning experiences, students will develop a strong set of skills and knowledge.
