IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Arrival at School

School hours are: 8:50am - 12:00pm (N/K morning program ends at 11:30) and 12:55pm - 3:30pm.

A friendly reminder to families that students should not arrive at school before 8:40 am (unless supervised by a parent/guardian, as there is no supervision before that time.

For lunch arrival, please ensure students arrive no earlier than 12:50 pm, as supervision is limited for our lunch program.

Dismissal

Students will be walked outside with their teacher into their pick up and drop off line on the hard top. Parents/guardians and older siblings will pick up students from their designated line. Please do not double park or stop along Alfred Avenue for pickup.
